# 1. Introduction

This document mainly provides the users with the necessary information to play Quake on the VisionFive system.

### 2. Preparation

Make sure you have prepared the following items.

### 2.1. Required Hardware

You need to prepare the following hardware items:

- VisionFive
- Micro-SD card (16 GB or more)
- PC with Linux OS
- USB to Serial Converter
- Ethernet cable
- Power adapter
- USB Type-C cable

### 2.2. Flashing Fedora OS to a Micro-SD Card

Now we need to burn Fedora (which is a Linux distribution) to a micro-SD card so that it can run on the VisionFive. Follow the steps in the *Flashing Fedora OS to a Micro-SD Card* section in the *VisionFive Single Board Computer Quick Start Guide*.

### 3. Playing Quake on VisionFive Fedora

To play Quake on VisionFive Fedora, perform the following:

### Compiling

1. Execute the following commands to compile codes on the VisionFive Fedora system:

```
sudo dnf install SDL*
cd ~
git clone https://github.com/JeremyAngCH/sdlquake
cd sdlquake
./autogen.sh
./configure && make
```

#### Download and Play Quake

2. Download the game from <a href="Quake">Quake</a> to the <a href="home">home</a> <a href="Quake">Quake</a> under the VisionFive Fedora system.



#### Tip:

<User\_Name> refers to the board user name.


3. Unzip the package by running:

```
cd ~
tar xvzf quakesw-1.0.6.tar.gz
cp id1/*.pak sdlquake/id1/
```

4. Start the game by executing:

```
cd sdlquake
./sdlquake -window -winsize 640 480
```
